

For those of you not in attendance at the Parents Association Meeting last week, we wanted to give you chance to fill out this sports survey. For those of you in attendance, we added one very important question at the end. The GCCA board is looking into options for the school to have sports teams. We have a very successful archery team and are wondering if there is interest in having other sports thru our school. There are many options in this regard and this survey is going to help us determine what the interest level is among kids and parents regarding sports. As it currently stands, if you child is fully enrolled at GCCA in 7th and 8th grade, they are not eligible to play sports in their home school district for the public school. If your child is home schooled, thru GCCA or on your own, they are eligible to play sports at their home district public school. The same would be true of high school, if we develop a full diploma granting high school. Therefore, this survey is intended to gage the interest level in 1) starting our own sports teams, 2) partnering with other public schools to have a sports team, 3) partnering with a home school network to have a sports team, 4) having no sports teams. Please answer these questions to the best of your ability and thank-you in advance for taking the time to fill this out.

- 1) Has your child competed in sports from ages 5-10? If yes, please list the sport

- 2) Has your child competed in sports from ages 11-14? If yes, please list the sport and what team/organization they have participated in.

- 3) Has your child competed in sports from ages 15-18? If yes, please list the sports and what team/organization they have participated in.

- 4) If you answered yes to #3 or #4: Were you happy with your child's sports experience? Is there something you would change about it?

- 5) If GCCA offered sports in 7th and 8th grade, would you consider having your child participate?

- 6) If GCCA doesn't offer sports in 7th and 8th grade, would you consider home schooling your child (thru GCCA), so that your child could play sports

- 7) If GCCA doesn't offer sports in 9-12th grades, would you consider sending your child to the public school or home schooling your child, so that your child could play sports?
